If you have large items that need to be collected on Trash Collection Day, please call Waste Management at 502-966-0117 to alert them so the item will be collected. Items which can be collected include:

Couch (wrap in plastic)

Chair (wrap in plastic)

Table

Mattress (1 - wrap in plastic)

Carpet cut in 4 ft. sections

Washer

Dryer

Hot Water Heater

Box Spring (1 - wrap in plastic)

Any item 50 pounds or less

It is the responsibility of the person owning or occupying the property to remove all rubbish, weeds, trash, waste, or litter from the center line easement that borders the property to the property lines.

If your property borders a public area such as sidewalks, driveways, parking spaces, and similar paved areas for public use, you are responsible for keeping this area free of all overhanging trees, shrubs, grass and other debris that blocks walkways as well as curbs and the street.
